 - iv. Carmencement-
 - 1. Staffing: More event support is needed from staff and faculty.
 - a. Staff & Faculty info session is May 18th at 11 AM via zoom.
 - b. We are in the process of hiring 55 student workers for the event. The students will be trained before the event.
 - *c.* We are planning a walk-through, and approx. 60 have signed up to participate.
 - v. Pre-recorded Ceremony- Premiering at 5:30 PM on May 27th.

 - The committee received an update on the revision process for BP5500. First Board meeting reading of teh BP was last night 5/5/21, and hopefully it will be an action item for approval at next meeting.
 - The committee received an update of the proposed revisions to AP5520. Changes for approval will go into the Fall 2021 semester. We are making progress with the AP, but we want to make sure it includes the Title IX information, which is still being reviewed and discussed.
