A BILL

Updating Bylaws to Change Serve Time In ASCC SB-2324-02

<u>Whereas:</u> Associated Students of Cerritos College officers who proudly serve the ASCC are currently limited to only 6 semesters in student government; and adjust it to 8 semesters.

Whereas: President Fierro currently has a 5-year plan for students to graduate.

<u>Whereas:</u> Those who are here for longer than 3 years can no longer serve, even though they have learned so much and have the desire to continue serving the ASCC; therefore, let the students serve longer as they are passionate about helping the students.

Resolved: The Associated Students of Cerritos College hereby amends the Bylaws of the Associated Students of Cerritos College by adding the following section to Article III, Section 1, Subsection 4:

To strike six (6) and insert eight (8), to read as follows:

4. No student shall serve more than a total of eight (8) semesters in the ASCC student government.

Resolved: The Associated Students of Cerritos College declare that these changes to the Bylaws and ASCC policy in general shall be applied starting the Spring semester of 2024.

Resolved: The Department of Student Activities, and in particular Dean of Student Services Elizabeth Miller and Student Events Specialist Esmeralda Murillo, shall upon passage of this Bill be sent an electronic copy of it, and are hereby requested to, as soon as possible, update the published copies of the Bylaws to reflect the changes made by the Bill.
