SENATE RESOLUTION

Stance of Support CCFF Comprehensive Healthcare SR-2324-01

Whereas: To ensure the success of our students we need to have a healthy faculty;

<u>Whereas:</u> Part-time community college faculty and their eligible dependents should have continuous access to health insurance benefits;

<u>Whereas:</u> It is estimated that thirty percent of part time faculty and their eligible dependents do not have access to affordable health insurance;

<u>Whereas:</u> The passage of <u>AB 190</u> has established significant and ongoing financial support for the colleges that offer Part Time Community College Faculty comprehensive healthcare;

<u>Whereas:</u> AB 190 has outlined specific tenets that colleges must meet to receive full reimbursement each academic year that include parameters for part time faculty eligibility, multi district part time faculty eligibility, and types of healthcare plans that can be offered; let it be

Resolved: The Associated Student Senate of Cerritos College support the Cerritos College Faculty Federation in their bargaining efforts to establish comprehensive healthcare options for the part time faculty at Cerritos College;

<u>Resolved:</u> The Associated Student Senate of Cerritos College urge the Board of Trustees implement a comprehensive healthcare program for part time faculty at Cerritos College that meets the criteria outlined in AB 190 no later than Spring 2024.
