

### **Executive Confirmation: Appointment of Associate Justices**

**Whereas:** Article II Section 8 Sub-section 1 of the ASCC Constitution states the following:  
The President shall have the power, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, to 152 appoint Ambassadors, Judges of the Court, and all other officers of the Associated 153 Students, whose appointments are not otherwise provided for, and which shall be 154 established by law.

Associate Justice Mia Fischer's and Sergio Cervantes's are compliant with Article III Section 3 'Justices shall carry an accumulative GPA of 2.00 at the time of their appointment.', Judicial Code 7.12 'The Court shall have no more than one (1) Chief Justice, and eight (8) Associate Justices, nor less than one (1) Chief Justice and four (4) Associate Justices.' and Judicial Code 7.14 'Justices shall hold their office for the full duration as regular full-time students of Cerritos College, although it shall be mandatory for any Justice to retire after the completion of six (6) full-time Fall and/or Spring Semesters of Court work.'

**Resolved:** The resolution of this executive order for Mia Fischer and Sergio Cervantes be appointed as associate justices, this resolution is compliant with Article II Section 8 Sub-section 1, Judicial Code 7.12, and Judicial Code 7.14.
