Legislation: Executive Cabinet Confirmation

Resolved: That Senate confirms the following students as members of the Executive Cabinet in compliance with Code Section II (Government Organization Code):

Director of Athletics - Raymundo Armendariz (2.733)

Duties include maintaining a direct channel of communication with the Health, Physical Education, and Athletics Department. Meet, once a month, with the Dean of Physical Education, and Director Athletics to discuss the issues facing athletics and help promote and coordinate interest in athletics. Maintain information pertinent to athletics, its promotion, and general information. Shall be responsible for presenting all budgetary requests regarding athletics.

Director of Inter-Club Council - Raul Leon (2.738)

Duties include serving as the chairperson of the Inter-Club Council. Maintain a direct channel of communication with all clubs and organizations on campus. Preside over all related functions, initiate disciplinary action regarding any organizational infraction of rules and regulations pertaining to such groups, with the approval of the Advisor to Inter-Club Council. Maintain a master calendar of all organizational events, supervising and coordinating the formation of new campus organizations and related constitutions. Work with the Advisor to Inter-Club Council, maintain an active roster of all campus organizations, determining the legality of membership after each semester

Treasurer - Katie Munteanu (2.732)

Duties include meeting, on a regular basis, with the Director of Student Activities to discuss the status of the ASCC Budget. Maintain an accurate evaluation of the finances and the financial status of the ASCC through presenting a financial report to the Senate at least once a month. Present any emergency reports on accounts or situations which require investigation or legislative action. Initiate, with the approval of the Executive Cabinet, all requests concerning finances to the Senate. Be chair of the Budget and Finance Committee. Be an Honorary Member of the Executive Board.

Director of DSPPS - Randy Diaz (2.735)

Duties include maintaining a direct channel of communication with the Office of Disabled Students. Work with the Director of Disabled Students in helping to promote and advocate the needs of disabled students. Attend Disabled Students Programs & Services (DSPPS) Advisory Committee meetings. Have a working knowledge of the needs and issues of the disabled students.

Director of Equity and Diversity - Jakob Pulido (2.734)

Duties include acting as a liaison and maintain a direct channel of communication between International students, DREAM, and AB540, Umoja, and all diverse constituents with the ACC. Be responsible for seeking and working with students and clubs on campus to promote Equity and Diversity. Be responsible for articulating the needs of students and providing availability of hours for consultation as a representative of the ASCC. Inform the ASCC of events, concerns, and needs relating to Equity and Diversity on campus and in the surrounding community. Be responsible for making informed decisions regarding equitable and diverse recommendations vital towards the improvement of Equity and Diversity.
