### **V.01 Role of the ICC Representative**

ICC rep is a critical role, acting as liaison between the office and club. Any information shared in ICC meetings are relayed back to the rep's respective club members

and officers.

### **V.02 Falcon's Nest Information**

Jennifer Soto, liaison for the Falcon's Nest presents information about the program. Falcon's nest strives to provide basic needs such as food, clothing, and shelter for Cerritos College students facing insecurities of said needs.

Studies show 3 out of 4 students don't have a stable source of food, 50% have unstable housing, and 13-14% have experienced homelessness.

Falcon's Nest's goal is to provide these needs so students can focus on pursuing their academic and career goals.

Clothing is also provided, including loaned blazers and dress clothes for job interviews.

Students only need to fill a single referral form to gain access to all of Falcon's Nest resources.

Franklin Market on campus is a free Falcon's Nest hosted grocery store with fresh produce and canned goods donated from stores such as Ralphs and Sprouts.

Falcon's Nest has also contracted with CalFresh, a government program that gives you a monetary stipend, commonly known as EBT, each month for food. There are two CalFresh representatives on campus.

Hygiene kits including toothbrushes, shampoo, and feminine products are also provided as well as resources for referrals to off campus assistance programs.

Falcon's Nest is also partnered with Jovenes, a housing program for Cerritos College students who are either homeless or experiencing unstable housing. Eligibility requirements include having completed at least one semester, but exceptions are given to special circumstances. Jovenes may also refer students to other housing programs.
