III.01 Director and Deputy Activity [20 min]

Director Parker moves to amend the resolution by striking 2022 and inserting 2023.

Seconded by Director Wang. With no objections the motion passes.

Deputy Arqueta and Director Parker go over the resolution and present it to the Cabinet.

Director Parker moves for a roll call vote. Director P. Shah seconds. With no objections, motion is approved.

With 8 yes, 4 no, and no abstentions, cabinet motions to approve JR-2223-04.
