I.03 Approval of Minutes:

III.01 Cerritos College & ASCC Mission Information, 10 minutes

The Cabinet shall receive a brief training on the Mission, Vision, and Values of Cerritos College and of the ASCC.

Dean of Student Services Dr. Elizabeth Miller summarizes the Cerritos College and ASCC Mission Statement, Vision Statement, and Cerritos College's Values. Brief information about Cerritos College's policies and procedures was also covered, ex. board policies and administrative procedures.

III.02 Cerritos College Paperwork Reduction Act (JL-2223-01) Action Item, 20 minutes

The Cabinet shall take action on a stance of support for JL-2223-01 "Cerritos College Paperwork Reduction Act" regarding reducing paperwork burdens and recognizing time complexity.

Director Parker presents the "Cerritos College Paperwork Reduction Act" bill proposal and briefly summarizes it. Questions about the bill were presented by the cabinet and answered by Director Parker and Dean of Student Services Dr. Elizabeth Miller.

Director Parker moves for a roll call vote on JL-2223-01. Deputy Wang Seconds this motion.

President Mohaddisa proposes to withhold the voting to the next cabinet meeting.

Director Parker withdraws motion for the roll call vote on JL-2223-01 and tables to move the voting to the next meeting. Vice President Gomez seconds this motion. No objections, the motion is approved.
