## Additional Model United Nations Funding for Spring 2025 SB-2425-03

<u>Whereas:</u> Cerritos College Model United Nations (MUN) was established with the primary objective of

teaching its members the importance of diplomacy, international relations, and foreign policy,

while facilitating a safe and competitive community within Cerritos College.

Whereas: The Cerritos Model United Nations club facilitates activities that prepares our delegates for

intercollegiate conferences that simulate real-world United Nations debates, fostering skills such as public speaking, negotiation, diplomacy, and critical thinking, which are essential for both

academic and professional development.

**Whereas:** The MUN team strives to represent Cerritos College at various conferences, promoting the

school's name and contributing to its academic reputation. Participation in these conferences enhances members' understanding of global issues and strengthens the college's connections

within the broader academic community.

Whereas: In addition to the academic benefits, attending conferences allows students to network with peers

from other institutions, providing opportunities for collaboration and professional development in

international relations, law, political science, and related fields.

**Whereas:** The Cerritos College Model United Nations requires funding to attend the end-of-year "Los

Angeles Model United Nations Conference" at The Biltmore Hotel from April 10-13, 2025. This funding will cover registration fees and accommodation expenses for participating members, allowing them to gain valuable hands-on experience that they can apply both inside and outside

the classroom.

**Whereas:** By supporting Cerritos College Model United Nations, the ASCC will be investing in a program

that helps develop the next generation of leaders, diplomats, and advocates for international

cooperation and peace.

**Whereas:** By having an award-winning club, a college can show its commitment to a well-rounded
