Audited courses cannot be used to meet any degree requirements or for financial aid, scholarships and athletic eligibility.

The fee to audit a class is \$15.00 per unit (in addition to the student fees). Students enrolled in 10 or more units can audit 3 units free (may be 3 one-unit classes). The \$15.00 per unit audit fee will automatically be charged if the student drops below 10 units. No refund of audit fees will be available. The California College Promise Grant (CCPG) will not cover the fee for an audit class.

SECTION II: FACULTY INFORMATION

Permission to audit a course is granted at the discretion of the instructor and with the instructor's signed permission.

With the instructors signed permission a student may enroll for audit status anytime during the semester after the first day of the course. (The first day of the course refers to the actual first course meeting.)

Credit students have priority over auditing students ($\underline{BP 4070}$). If a course closes after an auditor has been admitted, the auditor may be asked to withdrawal to make room for a credit student. Instructor discretion is strongly recommended
