PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS:

- 6,000 hours of on-the-job training over 3 years
- Just 20 Saturdays per year of instruction
- CPR and First Aid certification
- A wide-variety of hands-on painting projects
- Journeyman Graduation includes industry-approved, federal and state certifications from Cerritos College, and the Southern California Painting and Decorating Contractors of America United Apprentice Program

SUPPORT:

Women, non-binary individuals, and underrepresented populations enrolled in the Painters Apprenticeship Program program may be eligible for Equal Representation in Construction Apprenticeship (ERiCA) Grant, which offers childcare reimbursement and additional resources and mentorship support.
