- 2. Begin development of a continuous improvement model utilizing data from program review and annual planning, ultimately strengthening the culture across the campus through data driven decision-making.
- 3. Transition Cerritos College Online (CCO) to a permanent model of education delivery at Cerritos College.
- 4. Continue to prioritize students' basic needs as a part of our academic development initiatives.
- 5. Successful reaccreditation during fall 2021 follow-up visit.

- 1. Continue the development and/or expansion of educational programs to align with the needs of current and future labor markets and develop graduates with skills to satisfy the workplace demand.
