9 A Campus Safety Plan shall be developed and provided to students as part of the Annual
10 Security Report Brochure published by the Campus Police Department by October 1 of
11 each year. This report is also available online at www.cerritos.edu/police.

12 The Campus Police Department prepares and annually updates a report of all
13 occurrences reported to campus police of and arrests for crimes that are committed on
14 campus and that involve violence, hate violence, theft or destruction of property, illegal
15 drugs, or alcohol intoxication, and of all occurrences of non-criminal acts of hate violence
16 reported to campus authorities. A written report will be submitted to the Board of
17 Trustees.

18 Written records of non-criminal acts of hate violence shall include at least a description of
19 the act of hate violence, the victim characteristics, and offender characteristics, if known.

20 **Note:** Education Code, Section 67380 defines “hate violence” as: “any act
21 of intimidation or physical harassment, physical force or physical violence,
22 or the threat of physical force or physical violence, that is directed against
23 any person or group of persons or the property of any person or group of
24 persons because of the ethnicity, race, national origin, religion, sex, sexual
25 orientation, gender identity, gender expression, disability, or political or
26 religious beliefs of that person or group.” Section 67380 requires reporting
27 of both occurrences reported to campus police or safety authorities of and
28 arrests for crimes that involve hate violence (Section 67380(a)(1)(A)) and
29 of “non-criminal acts of hate violence” (Education Code, Section
30 67380(a)(1)(B)).

31 For purposes of reporting under the Clery Act, “hate crimes” include
32 domestic violence, dating violence, and stalking.

33 **Emergency Operations Plan**

34 The District shall develop and maintain an Emergency Operations Plan, which shall be
35 distributed as appropriate.
