1 **AP 4229 COURSE REPETITION – VARIABLE UNITS**

3 Title 5, Section 55044

4 Students may be permitted to enroll in variable unit open-entry/open-exit courses as many
5 times as necessary to enable them to complete the entire curriculum of the course once.

6 Students may not repeat variable unit open-entry/open-exit courses unless:

- 7 • The course is required for legally mandated training; or
- 8 • The course is a special class for students with disabilities which needs to be
9 repeated; or
- 10 • Repetition of the course is justified by extenuating circumstances; or
- 11 • The student wishes to repeat the course to alleviate substandard work.

12 A student may not enroll in a variable unit open-entry/open exit active participatory course
13 in physical education, visual arts, or performing arts more than one time.

14 When a course is repeated due to a significant lapse of time, the District may disregard
15 the previous grade and credit when computing a student's grade point average.
