1 **AP 4232 PASS/NO PASS**

3 Title 5, Section 55022

4 Courses may be offered in either or both of the following categories:

- 5 • Courses in which all students are evaluated on a “pass/no pass” basis.
- 6 • Courses in which each student may elect on registration, or within the first 30
- 7 percent of the course, to take the course on a “pass/no pass” basis.

8 A student electing to be evaluated on the “pass/no pass” basis will receive both course
9 credit and unit credit upon satisfactory completion of the course. In computing a student's
10 grade-point average, grades of “pass/no pass” are omitted.

11 A pass grade is granted for performance that is equivalent to the letter grade of "C" or
12 better. A student who fails to perform satisfactorily will be assigned a "no pass" grade.

13 The student is held responsible for all assignments and examinations required in the
14 course. The standards of evaluation are identical for all students in the course.
