Prior to seeking initial accreditation by any agency that accredits special programs, the
program shall obtain institutional approval to pursue external accreditation. Institutional
approval shall require the program to submit the following information to the Vice
President of Academic Affairs:

- 9 Accrediting agency name and purpose
- Fees and/or other costs associated with the accreditation process
- Rationale for seeking external program accreditation
- Any other information requested by the Vice President of Academic Affairs and/or
   the President/Superintendent
- Once approval to seek and/or renew external accreditation is granted by the Vice President of Academic Affairs, each program seeking or renewing external accreditation shall, in accordance with the processes and standards of the agencies that accredit special programs, prepare all required reports on time and host any required visits by representatives of the accrediting agency.
- Upon completion of the accreditation process, each program participating in external
   accreditation shall provide the following information to the Vice President of Academic
   Affairs:
- Copies and/or summaries of reports prepared by the accrediting agency
- Information about actions taken by the agency with respect to accreditation of the
   program
- Information about actions to be taken by the program as a result of the accreditation process and/or report
