AP 4010 ACADEMIC CALENDAR

Education Code, Sections 79020 and 88203;
Title 5, Sections 55700 et seq. and 58142

It shall be the responsibility of the Office of Academic Affairs to prepare the academic calendar including:

- The number of days that define an academic year (175 calendar days, including 173 days of instruction and two (2) days of faculty FLEX obligation)
- Processes for determining the academic calendar
- The holidays in which the college and offices of the District shall be closed on, which include:
 - New Year's Day (January 1)
 - Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (Third Monday in January)
 - Lincoln Day (February 12 or as allowable by Education Code, Section 79020)
 - Washington Day (Third Monday in February)
 - Memorial Day (Last Monday in May)
 - Juneteenth (June 19)
 - Independence Day (July 4)
 - Labor Day (First Monday in September)
 - Veterans Day (November 11 or as allowable by Education Code, Section 79020)
 - Thanksgiving Day (Fourth Thursday in November)
 - Day after Thanksgiving Day
 - Christmas Eve Day (December 24)
 - Christmas Day (December 25)
 - New Year's Eve Day
 - Other holidays, including Board of Trustees-declared holidays.
