### 6 High School, Regional Occupational Programs (ROP)

- 7 Articulation with high schools and ROPs may be course to course or program to program.
- 8 In either case, the Senior Manager, Dual Enrollment or designee shall coordinate the
- 9 process with the appropriate faculty and dean, both of whom must approve all written
- 10 articulation agreements.

#### 11 Other Colleges and Universities

- Designated responsibility for the processes associated with articulation between Cerritos
- 13 College and other colleges rests with a counseling faculty member with the title of
- 14 Articulation Officer. These processes incorporate the development, maintenance, and
- distribution of articulation agreements.
- The processes followed by the Articulation Officer follow guidelines provided in the
- 17 California Articulation Policies and Procedures Handbook developed by the California
- 18 Intersegmental Articulation Council (CIAC).
- Articulation responsibilities and processes include, but are not limited to, the following:
  - 1. Consulting with disciplinary faculty, department chairs, counseling faculty, and others, as appropriate;
  - 2. Providing necessary materials and information about course articulation proposals and acceptances;
  - 3. Initiating faculty-approved articulation agreements between Cerritos College and other institutions of higher education;
    - 4. Providing final review and approval for new articulation proposals and agreements between Cerritos College and institutions where agreements had not previously existed:
    - 5. Monitoring each stage of the articulation process and following up with department chairs, if necessary, for timely responses and decisions about articulation questions;
  - 6. Managing, reviewing, and updating campus articulation data on a regular basis;
- 7. Disseminating current, accurate articulation information to students, counseling faculty, department chairs and disciplinary faculty, and other appropriate campus personnel.
