- 3 Title 5, Section 55043
- 4 Students may be permitted or required to repeat courses in which a "C" or better grade
- 5 was earned where there was a significant lapse of time of no less than 35 months since
- 6 the grade was obtained and:
 - The District has established a recency prerequisite for a course or program; or
 - Another institution of higher education to which the student seeks to transfer has
 established a recency requirement which the student will not be able to satisfy
 without repeating the course in question.
- 11 When a student needs to repeat an active participatory experience course in physical
- education, or visual or performing arts, or that is related in content due to a significant
- lapse of time, each repetition attempt will be counted toward the established repetition
- limits. However, if a student has already exhausted the number of permitted repetitions,
- then an additional repetition due to significant lapse of time may be permitted or required
- by the District.
- 17 When a course is repeated due to a significant lapse of time, the District may disregard
- the previous grade and credit when computing a student's grade point average.
