- 4 Students may be permitted to enroll in variable unit open-entry/open-exit courses as many
- 5 times as necessary to enable them to complete the entire curriculum of the course once.
- 6 Students may not repeat variable unit open-entry/open-exit courses unless:
 - The course is required for legally mandated training; or
 - The course is a special class for students with disabilities which needs to be repeated; or
 - Repetition of the course is justified by extenuating circumstances; or
 - The student wishes to repeat the course to alleviate substandard work.
- A student may not enroll in a variable unit open-entry/open exit active participatory course
- in physical education, visual arts, or performing arts more than one time.
- When a course is repeated due to a significant lapse of time, the District may disregard
- the previous grade and credit when computing a student's grade point average.
