1 **AP 4232 PASS/NO PASS**

4 Courses may be offered in either or both of the following categories:

- 5 • Courses in which all students are evaluated on a “pass/no pass” basis.
- 6 • Courses in which each student may elect on registration, or no later than the last day
7 of instruction for the specific class session for which the student is enrolled as
8 published in the college’s class schedule, to take the course on a “pass/no pass” basis.

9 A student electing to be evaluated on the “pass/no pass” basis will receive both course
10 credit and unit credit upon satisfactory completion of the course. In computing a student's
11 grade-point average, grades of “pass/no pass” are omitted; however, units attempted for
12 which a student earns a grade of “NP” will be considered in probation or dismissal
13 determinations.

14 A pass grade is granted for performance that is equivalent to the letter grade of "C" or
15 better. A student who fails to perform satisfactorily will be assigned a "no pass" grade.

16 The student is held responsible for all assignments and examinations required in the
17 course. The standards of evaluation are identical for all students in the course.
