1 AP 5203 LACTATION ACCOMMODATION

3 Education Code, Section 66271.9

4 The District shall provide reasonable accommodations for a lactating student to express
5 breast milk, breast-feed an infant child, or address other needs related to breast-feeding
6 whenever a student is required to be present on campus. Reasonable accommodations
7 include, but are not limited to, all of the following:

- 8** 1. Access to a private and secure room, other than a restroom, to express breast
9 milk or breast-feed an infant child. The room shall have a comfortable place to sit
10 and have a table or shelf to place equipment described in paragraph (3).
- 11** 2. Permission to bring onto the college campus a breast pump and any other
12 equipment used to express breast milk.
- 13** 3. Access to a power source for a breast pump or any other equipment used to
14 express breast milk.

15 Lactating students shall be provided a reasonable amount of time to accommodate their
16 need to express breast milk or breast-feed an infant child.

17 Students shall not incur an academic penalty as a result of their use of the reasonable
18 accommodations, and shall be provided the opportunity to make up any work missed
19 due to such use.
