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- 3 Education Code, Section 76060
- 4 The District shall have one Associated Students organization.
- 5 Both day and evening student representatives shall be encouraged to participate in
- 6 student government.
- 7 A governing body shall be elected that shall keep an account of its meetings,
- 8 expenditures, authorizations, and policies established.
- 9 A simple majority (50% + plus 1) of the elected voting members of the Associated
- 10 Students governing body shall constitute a guorum.
- 11 The Associated Student organization is granted permission to use such District facilities,
- including office space, meeting and project spaces, and spaces for approved operations,
- as may be authorized subject to the determination by the District of the availability and
- suitability of such facilities for purposes specified by the Associated Student organization.
- Unless otherwise determined by the President/Superintendent or designee, such District
- facilities include, but are not necessarily limited to:
 - 1) offices in the Student Activities Office suite in the Bookstore (BK) Building;
 - 2) a shared student organizations and project room in the Student Activities Office suite in the Bookstore (BK) Building;
 - other designated shared reception and meeting space in the BK Building as determined by the President/Superintendent or designee;
 - 4) designated shared student dining, recreation, and related spaces in the Student Center Building; and/or
 - 5) such other space(s) as may be determined from time to time due to construction and construction-related maintenance, infrastructure, or other requirements as determined by the President/Superintendent or designee.
