- 15 • Hire and evaluate the President/Superintendent;
- 16 • Delegate power and authority to the President/Superintendent to effectively lead

- 18 • Assure fiscal health and stability, by adopting a responsible annual budget,
19 assuring fiscal oversight, and providing for independent audits;
