- 10 The District shall maintain a drug and alcohol free campus/workplace environment for
- 11 students and employees. The District prohibits the unlawful possession, use, or
- distribution of illicit drugs and/or alcohol by students and employees.
- 13 The unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensing, possession, or use of a controlled
- substance is prohibited in all facilities under the control and use of the District.
- Any student who violates this policy will be subject to disciplinary action, which may
- include, but is not limited to, referral to an appropriate rehabilitation program, suspension
- or expulsion. Any employee who violates this policy will be subject to disciplinary action
- up to and including termination. The District may refer students and employees who
- violate this policy to the Campus Police or other appropriate law enforcement agency for
- 20 appropriate criminal action.
- 21 The President/Superintendent shall assure that the District annually distributes the
- 22 information required by the Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act Amendments of
- 1989 to all students and employees and that the District complies with other requirements
- 24 of the Act.
- 25 The President/Superintendent shall ensure that a biennial report is prepared to review the
- 26 effectiveness of the District's policies and programs in maintaining a drug and alcohol free
- 27 campus and workplace environment.
