- 7 The District shall maintain a drug and alcohol free campus/workplace environment for 8 students and employees. The District prohibits the unlawful possession, use, or
- 9 distribution of illicit drugs and/or alcohol by students and employees.
- 10 The unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensing, possession, or use of a controlled
- 11 substance is prohibited in all facilities under the control and use of the District.

Any student who violates this policy will be subject to disciplinary action, which may include, but is not limited to, referral to an appropriate rehabilitation program, suspension or expulsion. Any employee who violates this policy will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including termination. The District may refer students and employees who violate this policy to the Campus Police or other appropriate law enforcement agency for appropriate criminal action.

18 The President/Superintendent shall assure that the District annually distributes the 19 information required by the Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act Amendments of 20 1989 to all students and employees and that the District complies with other 21 requirements of the Act.

The President/Superintendent shall ensure that a biennial report is prepared to review the effectiveness of the District's policies and programs in maintaining a drug and alcohol free campus and workplace environment.
