

**1 BP 4100 GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR DEGREES AND
2 CERTIFICATES OF ACHIEVEMENT**

6 The District grants the degrees of Associate in Arts and Associate in Science to those
7 students who have completed the subject requirements for graduation and who have
8 maintained at least a 2.0 average in degree-applicable units. Students must also
9 complete the general education, residency, and competency requirements set forth in
10 Title 5 regulations.

11 Students may be awarded Certificates of Achievement upon successful completion of a
12 minimum of 16 or more semester units of degree-applicable credit coursework designed
13 as a pattern of learning experiences designed to develop certain capabilities that may be
14 oriented to career or general education.

15 The President/Superintendent shall establish procedures to determine degree and
16 certificate requirements that include appropriate involvement of the local curriculum
17 committee.
