- 9 residency and competency requirements set forth in Title 5 regulations.
- Students may be awarded Certificates of Achievement upon successful completion of a
- minimum of 16 or more semester units of degree-applicable coursework designed as a
- pattern of learning experiences designed to develop certain capabilities that may be
- oriented to career or general education.
- 14 The President/Superintendent shall establish procedures to determine degree and
- certificate requirements that include appropriate involvement of the local curriculum
- committee. The procedures shall assure that graduation requirements are published in
- the College Catalog and included in other resources that are convenient for students.
