1 BP 5150 EXTENDED OPPORTUNITY PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

5 The Extended Opportunity Programs and Services (EOPS) provides “over and above”
6 support services and programs, in addition to the traditional student services programs,
7 to students who face economic as well as social, language, and/or educational barriers.
8 The supports provided assist students who have educational and economic
9 disadvantages to succeed academically in the College. The services may include, but
10 are not limited to: priority registration, academic counseling, one-on-one staff support,
11 grants, book and school supplies assistance, tutoring, transportation assistance, and
12 transfer support.

13 The President/Superintendent and the Vice President of Student Services in consultation
14 with the Dean of Student Equity and Success and the EOPS Director/Director of Special
15 Support Services, shall assure that the EOPS Program conforms to all requirements
16 established by the relevant law and regulations.
