The Extended Opportunity Programs and Services (EOPS) provides “over and above” support services and programs, in addition to the traditional student services programs, to students who face economic as well as social, language, and/or educational barriers. The supports provided assist students who have educational and economic disadvantages to succeed academically in the College. The services may include, but are not limited to: priority registration, academic counseling, one-on-one staff support, grants, book and school supplies assistance, tutoring, transportation assistance, and transfer support.

The President/Superintendent and the Vice President of Student Services in consultation with the Dean of Student Equity and Success and the EOPS Director/Director of Special Support Services, shall assure that the EOPS Program conforms to all requirements established by the relevant law and regulations.
