The services may include, but are not limited to, 9 priority registration, outreach, recruitment, orientation, assessment, tutorial services, 10 counseling and advising, book vouchers, transportation support, and financial assistance.

- 12 with the EOPS Director shall assure that the EOPS Program conforms to all requirements
- 13 established by the relevant law and regulations.
