## BP 7600 CAMPUS POLICE

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- 3 Education Code, Sections 72330 et seq.;
- 4 Government Code, Sections 3300 et seq. and 7070 et seq.
- 5 The Board of Trustees has established a Campus Police Department under the
- 6 supervision of one Chief of Campus Police, who shall report directly to the Vice President
- of Business Services. The department shall have jurisdiction to enforce the law on or
- 8 near the campus as provided by law and/or mutual aid agreements covering contiguous
- 9 law enforcement agency territory. The department shall maintain a Department Policy
- 10 Manual consisting of current state and federal legal standards and established best
- practices, as promulgated by the recognized police standards authority (currently Lexipol,
- 12 Inc.).
- 13 Campus Police officers shall be employed as members of the classified service and shall,
- when duly sworn, be peace officers as defined by law. Prior to employment, they shall
- satisfy the training requirements set out in Penal Code, Sections 830 et seq. Additional
- employment conditions and requirements shall be stipulated in AP 7600 titled Campus
- 17 Police.
- 18 The President/Superintendent or designee shall establish minimum qualifications of
- employment for the Chief of Campus Police including, but not limited to, prior employment
- 20 as a peace officer or completion of a peace officer training course approved by the
- 21 Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST).
- 22 The President/Superintendent shall ensure that every sworn member of the police
- 23 department satisfies the requirements of state law regarding qualifications for continued
- employment. These shall include meeting standards set by the California Commission
- on Peace Officer Standards and Training (California POST) including those pertaining to
- 26 firearms.
- 27 Every sworn member of the Campus Police Department shall be required to know and
- follow procedures for the use of weapons and force, including firearms, as stipulated in
- the current Department Policy Manual.
- 30 Every sworn member of the Campus Police Department shall be issued a suitable
- identification card and badge bearing the words "Cerritos College Police".
- 32 The President/Superintendent, in cooperation with the Chief of Campus Police, shall
- issue such other regulations as may be necessary for the administration of the Campus
- 34 Police Department.

# **Use of Military Equipment**

- The Chief of Police shall obtain approval from the Board of Trustees to adopt a military
- equipment use policy prior to purchasing, raising funds for, or acquiring military
- equipment. The President/Superintendent shall submit the proposed military equipment
- policy to the Board of Trustees and make those documents available on the police
- department website at least 30 days prior to any public hearing concerning the military
- equipment at issue. The Board of Trustees shall consider the proposed military equipment
- 42 policy as an agenda item for an open session meeting in accordance with the Brown Act.

### 43 Use of Force

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- The Board of Trustees directs the Chief of Police to establish operational guidelines
- regarding reasonable use of force for Campus Police Officers. The Board expects every
- Campus police officer to carry out their duties, including the use of force, in a fair and
- 47 unbiased manner and to use reasonable force in any situation and make decisions in a
- 48 professional, impartial, and reasonable manner and to use de-escalation techniques
- 49 whenever possible.

# **Report Regarding Complaints**

- 51 When requested, the Chief of Police shall provide the Board of Trustees with a report
- regarding complaints against the police department and police officers. This report must
- 53 disaggregate the complainants by race, gender, religion, or any other characteristic
- identified by the Board.
