BP 7330 COMMUNICABLE DISEASE

- 3 Education Code, Sections 87408, 87408.6, and 88021
- 4 All newly hired academic employees who have not previously been employed in a school
- 5 district in California shall have on file a medical certificate indicating freedom from
- 6 communicable diseases, including active tuberculosis. No academic employee shall
- 7 commence service until such medical certificate has been provided to the District.
- 8 All newly hired academic or classified employees who have not previously been employed
- 9 in a school district in California must show that within the past 60 days they have submitted
- 10 to a tuberculosis risk assessment and, if risk factors are present, have been examined to
- determine that they are free from active tuberculosis. If risk factors were present at the
- 12 tuberculosis risk assessment, and an examination occurs, after the examination the
- 13 employee shall provide the District with a certificate from the employee's examining
- 14 physician showing that the employee was examined and found to be free from active
- 15 tuberculosis.
- All employees shall be required to undergo a tuberculosis risk assessment within four years
- of employment and every four years thereafter to determine if they are free from active
- 18 tuberculosis.
