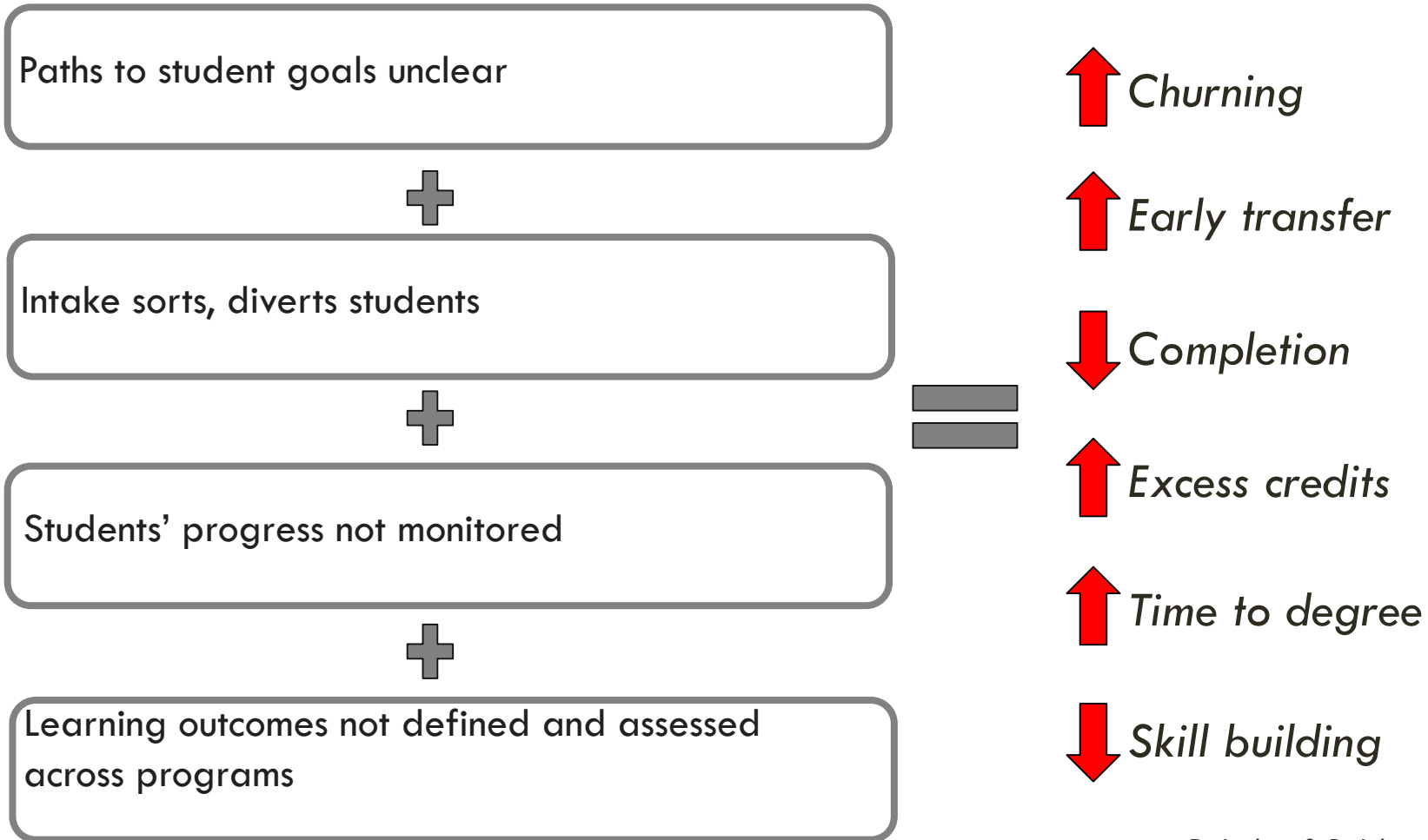

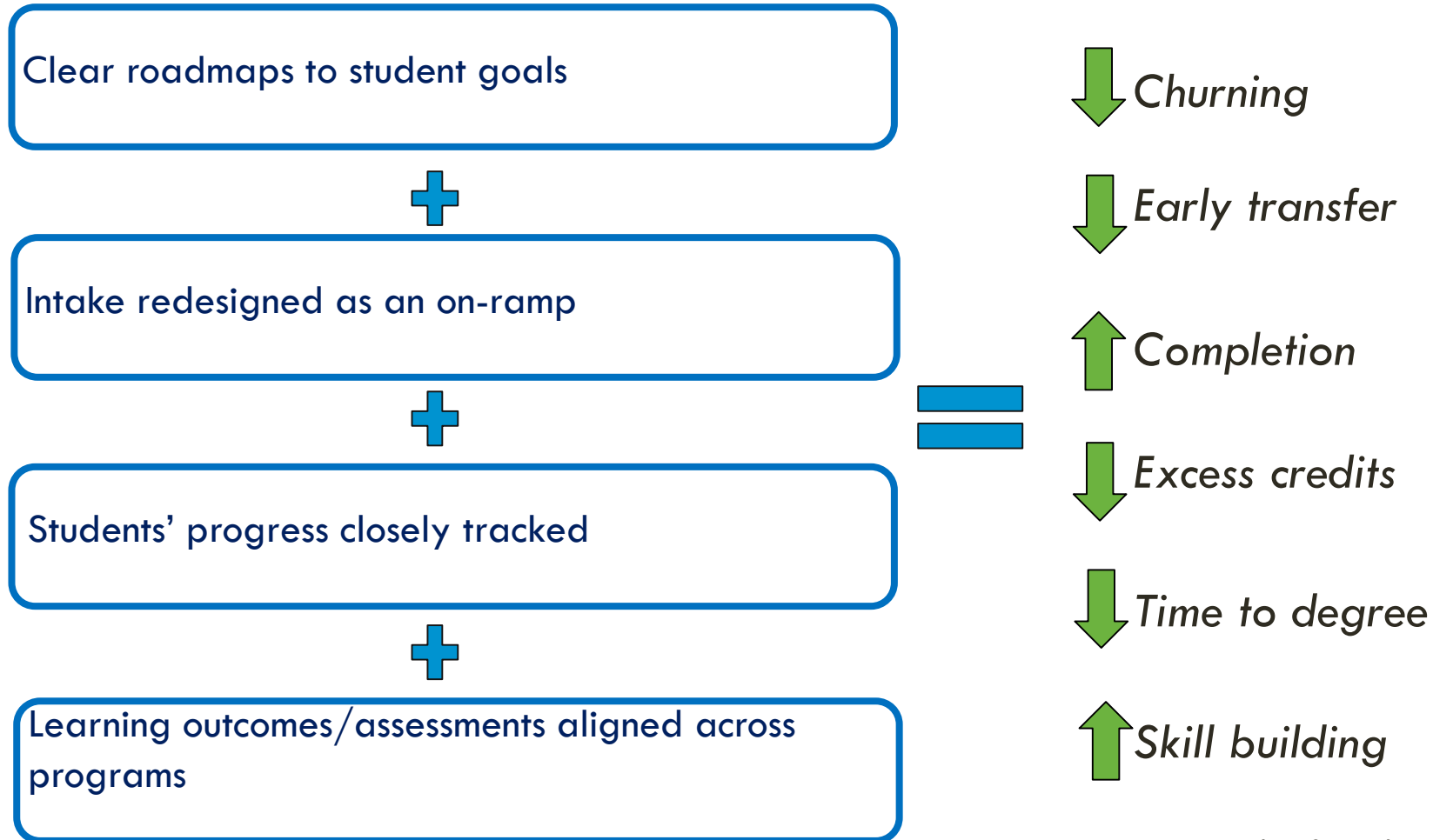

4. Provide courses to students when they need them



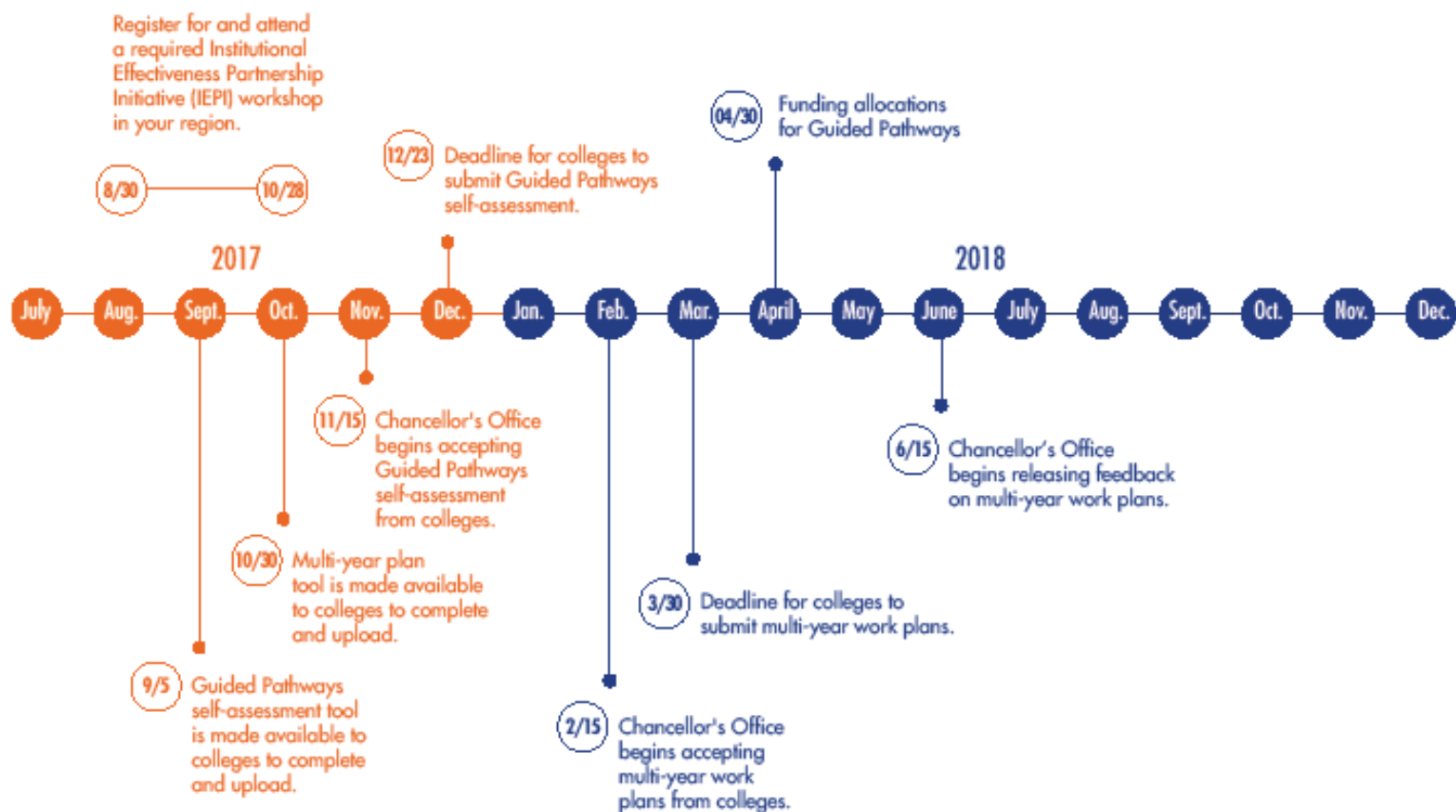
The State of California has designated
