- 2 will be my last meeting. We had

- 6 Resolutions which I Emailed to
- 7 you this evening regarding the
- 8 board policy 7210 so I just like
- 9 to read the results for that.
- 10 The first one is the Resolution
- 11 supportive of faculty evaluation
- 12 procedure in the tenure granting
- 13 process. Therefore be resolved
- 14 Faculty Senate regards that
- 15 decisions are made in accordance
- 16 with the evaluation procedures
- 17 established by the evaluation of

18 probationary faculty in the Collective Bargaining Agreement 19 and in accordance with the requirement of Ed Code and be resolved that the faculty recommends removing language from this policy that infringes on policies and procedures Sample footer

- concerning the tenure
- 2 probationary faculty. The
- second one is a res in support
- of minimum qualification
- exercise standards for faculty
- and resolve that the September
- recommends removing the
- Bachelor's Degree requirement
- from this board policy. Thank
- 10 you.
- 11 >> President Lewis: Thank
- 12 you.
- >> Good evening. I just want
- to take a second to publicly
- 15 thank you for funding for the

- 16 library for extended hours.
- 17 I worked the late shift last
- 18 Thursday and we kept stats and
- 19 1130 at night there were 75
- 20 people in the library. I just
- 21 checked out the stats from the
- 22 week because the Chair showed me
- 23 and there were 100 students in
- 24 the library during a time we
- 25 would be normally closed and

- 1 which is great and people
- 2 studying and getting tutoring.
- 3 I had to kick the tutor off at
- 4 12:55 p.m. because I had to go
- 5 home and we close at one and
- 6 there was hanging out and if you
- 7 remember college that's part of
- 8 the experience and you work hard
- 9 and build the relationships and
- 10 that sustains you through the
- 11 hard time. When I was thinking
- 12 of telling you this I was
- 13 remembering my own experience
- 14 and I was a film major and we

- 15 spend a lot of time with and to
- 16 this day the people I like to do
- 17 work with are journalists and
- 18 film people because of those
- 19 feelings and thank you so much
- 20 for the resources to provide our
- 21 students with that opportunity.
- 22 It was really great and made us
- 23 feel proud to work here so I
- 24 wanted to share that with you
- 25 guys. Second thing I hope

- 1 tonight when close session that
- 2 Dr. Fierro shares the new
- 3 funding formula proposed and I
- 4 am looking from something from
- 5 the Department of Finance and
- 6 next year we will get
- 7 \$16 million more than last year
- 8 based on certain assumptions and
- 9 imagine how wonderful this place
- 10 could be with those funds and we
- 11 know there are ideas and how to
- 12 spend it and I hope they come

- 13 together in harmony. Lastly I wanted to give you a negotiations update from our perspective and I am sure you're getting one from the district and people you hired to 18 negotiate for you. Our contract is going to expire on June 30 20 and we have been working hard
- 22 all year to have a new contract
- in place before this happens but
- it doesn't look like it's going
- to happen and right now we have

- only have three dates between
- thou and June 30 and ask the
- district to provide the people
- that you have charged on the
- negotiations team with the time
- they need to meet us for extra

- 7 rather than just showing up with
- a problem which something and I

- 9 think all of us appreciate on

- 18 motion is approved. We move on
- 19 to reports and comments from
- 20 district officials starting with
- 21 Student Trustee Raul Avalos.
- 22 >> Val: So I would like to
- 23 thank everyone here at the
- 24 board, the VPs sitting here and
- 25 Michelle everyone, the students

- 1 and ASCC for always being
- 2 helpful and also for you guys
- 3 taking the time for listening to
- 4 the things that I kind of have
- 5 ideas with. Some things that I
- 6 did this past week was attend

- 16 and talking to Chancellor and
- 17 the Chancellor's staff and a lot
- 18 of different people who help us
- 19 advocate and build a different
- 20 model while not all the
- 21 recommendations that were
- 22 provided by our work group were
- 23 accepted by the Chancellor. The
- 24 large portion of the
- 25 recommendations that were

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- 1 provided were accepted. I sent
- 2 an Email to the campus with the
- 3 comparison of the two and we
- 4 will provide additional updates
- 5 as we get them. I am a bit

- 6 skeptical of the spread of the
- 7 funding because I'm not sure
- 8 where they're going to get all
- 9 that money from, but hopefully
- 10 it comes out that way or very
- 11 close and obviously we will not
- 12 have to be concerned for our
- 13 funding for the next two years.
- 14 One thing that is very sure
- 15 apparently at this point we
- 16 won't get any less allocation
- 17 than we received the previous
- 18 year so I think that is probably
- 19 worst case scenario at this
- 20 particular point but obviously
- 21 we don't know until additional
- 22 discussion takes place, but it's
- 23 looking much better from and
- 24 concerned and obviously I want
- 25 to thank everyone that have

- 1 reach out to their legislators
- 2 and everyone that I had the
- 3 opportunity to work in

- 4 Sacramento and the league and
- 5 the board group also work on
- 6 these, so thank you for that.
- 7 It was a bit of work there.
- 8 Obviously the partnership that
- 9 we develop with the other single
- 10 campuses help to solidify the
- 11 position on how this budget will
- 12 affect us, and we seem to be
- 13 coming on the best end of this
- 14 equation so -- as I said my mom
- 15 used to say "don't count your
- 16 chickens until the egg hatches
- 17 or something like that".
- 18 >> [INAUDIBLE].
- 19 >> Dr. Fierro: So I will wait
- 20 a little bit but I am less
- 21 concerned at this point. The
- 22 other part of the budget and
- 23 seems to be moving quickly.
- 24 There were some changes last
- 25 time and the online college is

- 1 growing on support. Very
- 2 unlikely to see -- it will be

- 3 unlikely it will not happen in
- 4 some way at the very least but
- 5 the support continues to grow --
- 6 >> [INAUDIBLE] [Off Mic].
- 7 >> I know they were looking at
- 8 three pathways. Did they decide
- 9 on the three pathways? And have
- 10 we had the opportunity to
- 11 comment what pathway as Cerritos
- 12 College would like to see as a
- 13 possible online college?
- 14 >> Dr. Fierro: No. We
- 15 haven't had the opportunity to
- 16 comment and it has not been to
- 17 -- to my understanding not fully
- 18 defined. The only program that
- 19 has been advertised is medical
- 20 coding but we did not get the
- 21 opportunity at this point to
- 22 comment. It doesn't mean that I
- 23 will not submit a position on
- 24 this.
- 25 >> Marisa Perez: Yeah, I

- 1 would like outreach to the
- 2 faculty leaders and this is the
- 3 proposal going on. I just think
- 4 it's very vague. Every time I
- 5 hear it it's vague so again it's
- 6 going to happen. I mean let's
- 7 put there it's going to happen
- 8 and those on the other side of
- 9 the fence come on over because
- 10 it's going to happen and what
- 11 will work best for the faculty
- 12 and the student and the
- 13 community and it's going to
- 14 happen and at least let's be a
- 15 leader. That's where I am at
- 16 this point.
- 17 >> Dr. Fierro: Agreed. We
- 18 had a number of conversations
- 19 with Michelle and Michelle is
- 20 going to lead an initiative on
- 21 the online program at Cerritos
- 22 College to expand the program.
- 23 Look at the standards and any
- 24 opportunities for us to move
- 25 from course offering to program

- 1 base offerings. Hopefully we
- 2 can move faster than the state
- 3 is able to move. If we cannot
- 4 move faster than the state
- 5 that's a sad state of affairs
- 6 but I think we can move to be
- 7 ahead at the time of the online
- 8 college roll out and presenting
- 9 at the next board meeting and
- 10 thank you for the work you have
- 11 been doing so we have been
- 12 having the conversations and
- 13 will continue to have the
- 14 conversations on campus because
- 15 my position on the online
- 16 college is the same I have with
- 17 regards of our neighboring
- 18 districts. They're here.
- 19 They're going to try to take the
- 20 students and try to offer better
- 21 programs so some thing with the
- 22 online college and the
- 23 opportunity to expand programs
- 24 and we as well do it better than
- 25 they do so we keep our students

- 1 where they are and serve our
- 2 community in the best possible
- 3 way. We have been going through
- 4 May madness. We've had many
- 5 events almost every evening. I
- 6 think I have been at every event
- 7 with the exception of Saturday
- 8 event when I was doing the
- 9 presentation in Valencia but I
- 10 think Dr. Johnson was there and
- 11 we have been attending the many
- 12 events. It's great to see
- 13 faculty, staff and I cannot say
- 14 it enough how quickly our
- 15 facilities people turn around
- 16 those rooms and clean them up,
- 17 and they're fast, so
- 18 congratulations and thank you to
- 19 them because as many events and

- 22 work they're doing.
