Every year, the **Associated Students of Cerritos College (ASCC)** is honored to support the students of Cerritos College by leading and sponsoring events, activities, programs, scholarships, employment, and resources that enable our community to flourish. This year, **the ASCC Budget & Finance Committee** reviewed a record total of **140** requests from a variety of associated groups, including our Office of Student Life & Leadership, student organizations, academic departments, the athletics program, and campus services. These requests totaled **\$2,491,374.14**. Of these requests, after deliberation by the ASCC Senate, **136** requests were approved for a total of **\$1,545,696.00** to be allocated in the **academic year 2026–2027** and **fiscal year 2027 (FY27)**.

This budget builds on the amazing growth that Cerritos College and our students experienced during 2025–2026, and ASCC optimistically hopes this momentum continues into the new term. For this, the Committee, made up of volunteer students and staff, spent over 20 hours meeting to review requests individually, while adopting new Standing Rules and data tools to assist with the review. The Committee's efforts contributed to the ASCC Senate's approval of FY27's budget in only two meetings, significantly faster than previous years.

Standing Rules

2025–2026 ASCC Budget & Finance Committee for 2026–2027 Budget

The Associated Students of Cerritos College or (“ASCC”)

The ASCC Budget & Finance Committee or (“the Committee”)

Clubs, organizations, departments, and any other entity requesting funding from ASCC or (“groups”)

Funding Limitations

The Committee adheres to the following for all requests:

1. **Fundraising**—Will not approve funding for group expenditures related to fundraising, unless allocated through an approved request to ICC.
2. **Incentives**—Will not approve funding for financial incentives to join a student club/organization.
3. **Food & Refreshments**—May approve funding for food, drinks, and refreshments at club meetings, however it is limited to no more than \$300 per year.
4. **Honorariums/Guest Speakers**—May approve funding for honorariums/guest speakers, however it is limited to no more than \$2,500 per year.
5. **Student Awards & Scholarships**—May approve funding for monetary student awards and scholarships, however it is limited to no more than \$200 per person per award.
6. **Wages**—May approve funding for faculty and staff wages, salaries, or stipends, however it is limited to no more than \$75/hour.

Compliance & Eligibility

For requests to be considered and for groups to be able to access funds, requests must meet the following requirements:

1. **Legality**—ASCC-sponsored events/programs must adhere to current District policies, procedures, and guidance, and to local, state, and federal ordinances and laws.
2. **Branding**—Publicity and media for ASCC-sponsored events, activities, or trips must include the language “funding provided by” or “funding provided in part by,” accompanied with the ASCC logo.
3. **Registration**—If a student club/organization, they must be fully registered with the Office of Student Activities the year the funds are allocated to access the funding.
