This role is especially focused on incorporating Indigenous values, traditions, and teachings into daily activities, helping children develop a strong sense of identity and community. The role involves supervising children, engaging them in age-appropriate activities, ensuring their well-being, and fostering their social, emotional, cognitive, and physical development.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

Supervision and Safety:

- Ensure the safety and well-being of children at all times.
- Maintain a clean, organized, and child-friendly environment.
- Monitor children during indoor and outdoor activities.
- Follow all safety protocols and procedures.

Child Development:

- Plan and implement age-appropriate lessons, activities, and play-based learning experiences that promote physical, emotional, social, and cognitive development.
- Encourage positive behavior and manage challenging behaviors using appropriate techniques.
- Support children's emotional and social development by encouraging positive behavior, problem-solving, and self-expression
- Support children in developing self-help skills, such as dressing and eating.
