# ESTHETICIAN PROGRAM INFORMATION & RESOURCES

#### **Program Overview**

This program will prepare you for a career in esthetics by providing you the skills to perform various facilas services with the use of modalities, hair removal (waxing and sugaring), eyelash extensions, makeup, lash lifts and brow lamination.

The Board of Barbering and Cosmetology requires a minimum of 600-clocked hours, technicals and operations.

## **Program Pre-requisites**

Completion of ENGL 100 or ENGL 100S or equivalent with a grade of "C" or higher or "Pass".

#### Program Pathway (flyer)

This program takes one 18-week semester comprised of two 9-week sessions (session #1 and session #2 courses). Students can begin this program every 9-weeks during major terms (Fall and Spring).
