1. How does your program meet a documented labor market demand?

Total employment for Architectural and Civil Drafters in the region increased 7.3% from 3,581 persons in 2010 to 3,842 persons in 2015. Regional job openings during the 2015-2020 period are projected to be 254 persons or about 50 per year.

2. How does your program ensure unnecessary duplication of other labor training programs in the area?

There were only 77 total Approved Certificates in Architecture and Architectural Technology earned in the region during the 2015-2016 academic year. There is no duplication of training programs in the region.

3. How does your program demonstrate effectiveness as measured by the employment and completion success of its students?

Of the 13 community colleges in the region:

- Cerritos College ranks 4th for students who earned an Approved Certificate in Architecture and Architectural Technology with 7.
- Cerritos College ranks 5th in FTES in Architecture and Architectural Technology with 86.
