 - A faculty member was concerned with the word "assessment"
 - Frank Mixson clarified that assessment is still needed in the prerequisite wording as ESL department is still allowed to give students assessment testing. The word "placement process" is in reference to multiple measures where students transcripts will help determine what level of Math or English course they will get placed in
- Lynn Serwin
 - Lynn stated that her department did not have any problems with adding the word "assessment/placement process" to prerequisite.

The committee will continue to communicate with their department with the additional wording to prerequisites, but would like a letter (or memorandum) to take back to their department before discussing the matter any further. The letter of intent will help members relay the message properly and reduce potential miscommunication. Pass/no pass option will also be added to the letter to ask their department to consider adding this option for students.
