DE Data and You: Accessibility

This workshop will prepare faculty participants for an exciting opportunity to help collect distance education (DE) student survey data. In partnership with the DE team and IERP, interested participants may become pilot testers for a DE student accessibility survey. In the first workshop, participants will learn about the accessibility dimensions being surveyed, review the survey procedures, and receive materials for encouraging student participation. After the completion of the survey, participants will receive a report of student perceptions of accessibility in their DE courses. Participants are also invited to attend a follow-up workshop to debrief the results and make actionable accessibility changes.
