WHAT TO BRING & EXPECT AT THE SITE

- For married filing joint, both spouses must be present
- Proof of identification (photo ID) for yourself and/or your spouse
- All Forms W-2 and 1099
- Information for other income and all deductions/credits
- A copy of last year's tax return (optional)
- Social Security cards or Individual Taxpayer Identification Notices/Cards (ITIN) for you, your spouse, and dependents
- Bank account and routing number (for direct deposit refund)
- Forms 1095-A, B, or C (ACA Statements)
- For prior year returns, copies of income transcripts from IRS (and state, if applicable)

Note: This event does not offer services pertaining to business income with a loss (Schedule C) or capital gains (Schedule D)
