The course is designed to help the learner make wise spending, saving, and credit decisions and to make effective use of income to achieve personal financial success. Procedures for Course Articulation:







Cerritos College credit for the articulated course listed above may be received when the following criteria are met:

5. A maximum of 30 units may be awarded through credit by examination.
