Math

MATH 104 – Survey of Math: For an associate degree in Applied Tech, Skilled Trades, Business, Accounting, Law, or Education & Human Services.

MATH 110A – Math for Elementary School Teachers: For transferring to CSU as an elementary school teaching major.

STAT C1000 (formerly MATH 112)– Elementary Statistics: For transferring to CSU in Arts, Humanities, Geography, or Communication.

MATH 116 – Calculus for Managerial, Biological, and Social Sciences: For transferring to CSU and UC in Business, Biology, and Sociology.

MATH 155 – Precalculus or Math 170 – Calculus: For transferring to CSU or UC in Science, Engineering, or Math.

English

ESL 180 – College Composition for Multilingual Students: For an associate degree or transfer to CSU or UC in all majors.

ENGL C1000 (formerly ENGL 100)–Academic Reading and Writing: For an associate degree or transfer to CSU or UC in all majors.

ENGL C1000E (formerly ENGL 100S)–Academic Reading and Writing with Embedded Support: For an associate degree or transfer to CSU or UC in all majors.
