1. Engaging the larger campus community

- Traci and Frank narrowed down and refined some questions to start with:
 - How many students are reaching their educational goals (by major)?
 - How many units do students accumulate in reaching their educational goals (by major)?
 - How many semesters does it take students to reach their educational goals (by major)?
 - At what point in their progression do we lose the greatest number of students?
- Traci shared that Kristi had indicated that their BI tool can generate time to completion or "progression" data (e.g., where we are losing students, how long it is taking them, etc.), but there were problems with data not loading. Data is now loaded to 2015, but not pre-2015, which would be good for more comparative cohorts). Pauline has been working on a report and should have something after spring break.
