 - There were over 500 responses to the survey
 - Pauline is working on the analysis, which should be ready in about a week.
 - There were differences in understanding of what data the committee would be able to see. While some on the committee understood that they would be able to see all of the comments, Kristi stated her office will provide a summary. They do not share unitary data and will not provide all of the comments. Traci noted the difference in understanding and suggested she and Kristi continue the discussion offline.
 - There were over 300 responses to the Google Docs from the walk-up activity.
 - Traci shared the data, including comments
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 - How many students are reaching their educational goals (by major)?
 - How many units do students accumulate in reaching their educational goals (by major)?
 - How many semesters does it take students to reach their educational goals (by major)?
 - At what point in their progression do we lose the greatest number of students?
