1. GP: Year in Review

- Task forces
 - Tracking, IT, and IERP—Met a couple of times. Overlapped with MMAP. Going on an “as needed” basis. Wondering if structure and coding of areas of interest are coded in PeopleSoft (If not, when?). IERP needs them coded into the warehouse. (Areas of Interest are not formalized yet.)
 - Student Input/Focus Groups—Clara will be helping the task force along
 - Student Guidance and Support—Shawna and Jamie were leading. Met and are developing a booklet. Interviewed different student support services across campus. Have all info just need to put into template. Include timeline that students could follow (i.e., when they should go to each of the services). Put all this info together and give it to communication or composition of pathways task force.

2. GP: The Year(s) Ahead

- GP will be a 5-year roll out
- Track performance indicators set by CCCCCO
 - Kristi hasn't heard anything from chancellor's office
 - Metric simplification? Some of them could be used for GP measurement. Haven't seen anything specifically for GP measurement. Culture change, so probably not going to ask for set metrics. Going to graduation rates; may not come up with a unique set of metric rates (Rick)
- Integrate GP into planning processes
 - Resource allocation planning document. Kristi took it from 21 to 5 pages with a picture.
 - So many different plans. Hard to keep track. Need to make sure we are tying them all together.

- Talked last year about shared governance committees to include a goal attached to a GP pillar. Multiple plans: EMP, strategic plan, integrated plan, guided pathways plan, facilities plan, IT plans, legislation plans (AB 705, MMAP). All these things are aligning. Opportunity to align them all. Chancellor's Office is asking us to align all our services. Not at loss of funds for any of these plans, however at loss of clarity at how these plans can leverage each other. Consider how the task forces align with the 4 pillars.
- Matched planning documents to the Chancellor's Vision for Success goals. Opportunities take that document and figure out how to map them to the 4 pillars.
- Reassess need and focus of task forces/subcommittees
 - Have to develop that lexicon on campus that everyone is using
 - Curriculum maps – broader area of interests maps?
- Pursue electronic template for layout and distribution of pathways information ([Bakersfield example](#))
 - Recommended, not prescribed
 - Interactive map for students
 - Been working on this for 2-3 years
 - We can participate in the pilot, but have to give them SLO data
 - Will get more information on Thursday (webinar)
- Develop brief career assessment or interest inventory to integrate into AOC process and link to AOs and specific majors ([Holland codes](#))
 - Put together a short interest inventory that students could use to identify a broad area and link those to the areas of interest
 - www.cacareerzone.org – quick assessment
- Investigate tools/methods for early alert and other student support and guidance efforts that help students stay on their paths (e.g., Starfish)
- Develop plan for marketing/awareness campaign including branding, document design, etc.
- Develop a strategic timeline
