

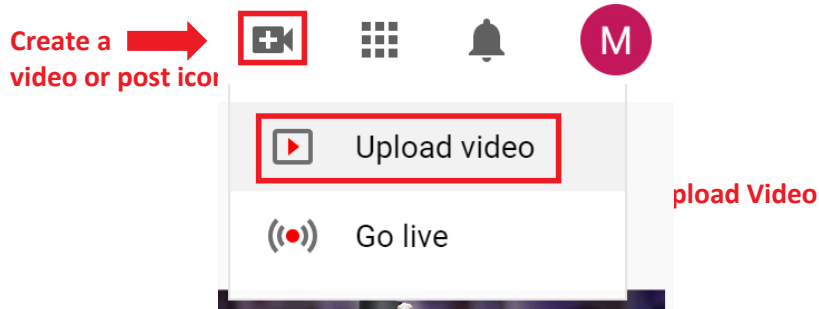
How to add a YouTube Video to Canvas

Below are instructions on “How to Upload Videos to YouTube” and “How to embed a YouTube video into Canvas”.

How to Upload Videos to YouTube

Use the instructions below to upload videos to YouTube from a computer. For instructions to upload videos using a mobile device, please visit [YouTube: Android Video Upload](#) or [YouTube: iPhone & iPad Video Upload](#).

1. Sign in to [YouTube](#). If you do not have an account, you can [create an account](#) with Google.
2. Click on the *Create a video or post* icon located at the upper right corner of the screen.



3. Click *Select File*. Then, locate the video you wish to upload.
4. Fill in the video details while your video is being processed. Then, click *Next*.

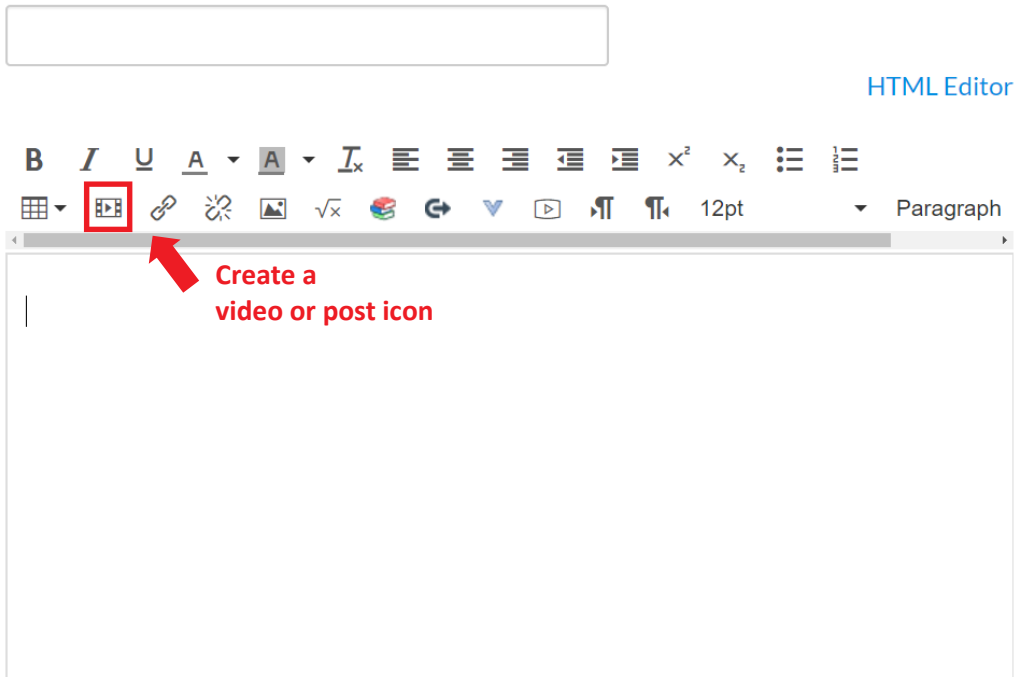

5. Add Video elements. Use cards and an end screen to show viewer related videos, websites, and call to action. **Please note:** This is optional. Then, click *Next*.
6. Add Visibility. Visibility allows you to choose when to publish and who can see your video. Then, click *Save*.

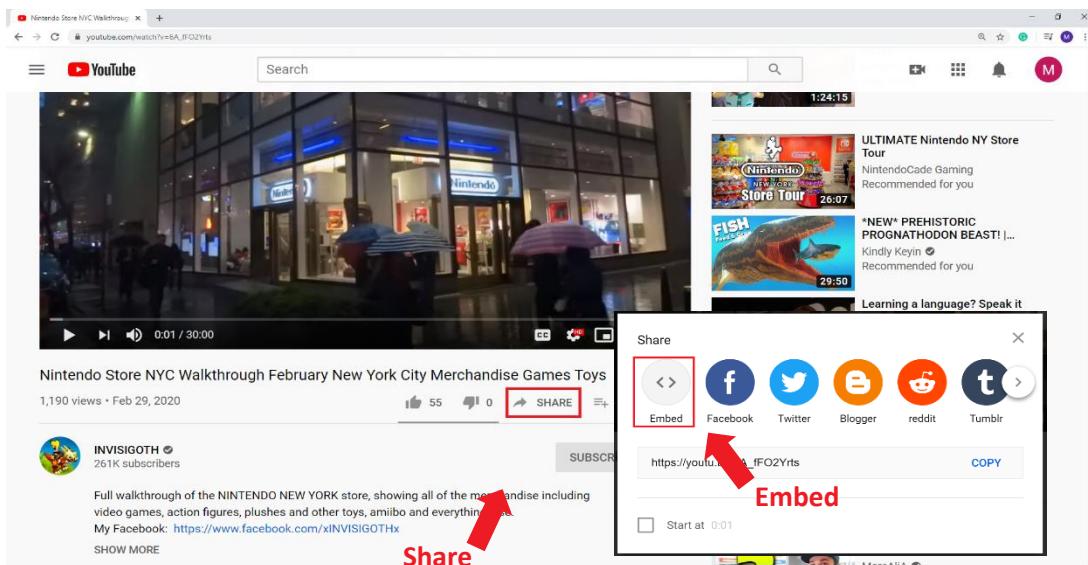
How to Embed a YouTube Video into Canvas

Instructors can embed a YouTube video into any textbox using Announcements, Pages, Syllabus, Assignments, Discussions, and Quizzes.

1. Click inside the textbox you wish to embed a YouTube video in.



2. Paste your embed code into the textbox, then click *Ok*.
 - a. To locate the embed code on YouTube, click *Share*, then click *Embed*. You can now copy the embedded code.



3. Remember to *Save and Publish*.
