Take-Aways

Accessibility = Usability

- **Determine best format/strategy** for delivering content PDF, Word, or Canvas page.
- **Explain how formatting impacts** assistive technology to access and interpret information.
- **Format external information** into a Canvas Page (copy and paste without unnecessary tags).
- Utilize the Rich Content Editor to properly format content pages using the acronym 'LIST'.
- Run the Canvas' Page Accessibility Checker/Pope Tech Instructor Accessibility Guide and interpret its results to remediate inaccessible instructional materials.
- Use color properly & recognize effective video captioning.
