## Statement of Support

This Affidavit of support must be completed by the individual who plans to sponsor the prospective International student while attending Cerritos College.

United States Citizenship & Immigration Services (USCIS) regulations require that Cerritos College obtain reliable documentation that all F-1 students have sufficient funding to pay all expenses necessary to support their tuition, fees, living expense, and other expenses for their duration of program of study of a minimum of two (2) years.

Sponsor must complete this Affidavit of Financial Support and attach the sponsor's current bank statement showing funds with a minimum amount of \$24,000 U.S. dollars. The bank statement must be within three (3) months of submitting the admission application. Bank statement must be on a bank official letterhead and include the sponsor's name.

This affidavit is completed by the sponsor listed below for the purpose of assuring Cerritos College and the United States Government that the international student named below will not become a public charge while in the United States.

**Please Note:** International students are not eligible for financial aid or any other government assistance.
